Introduction to Carl Jung:

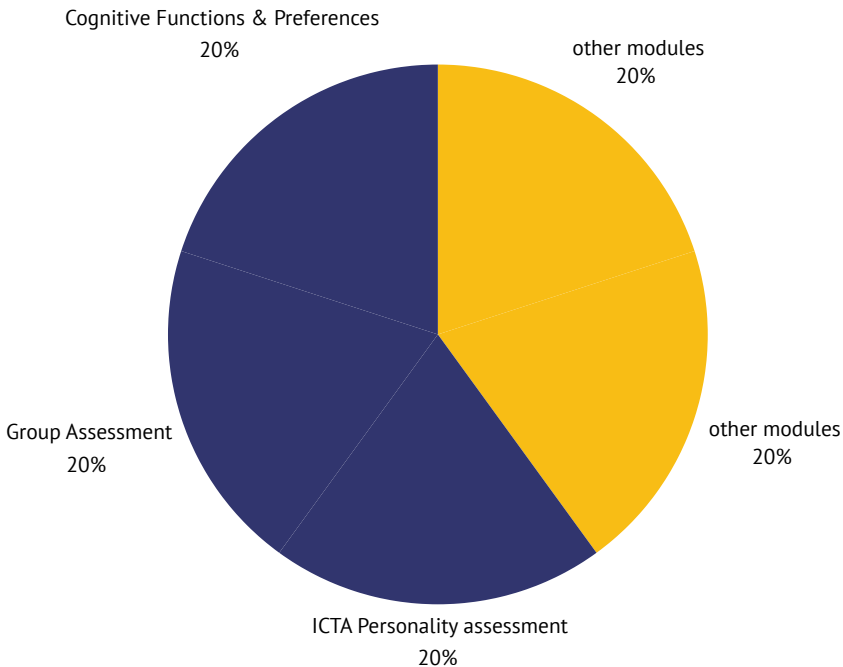
- Participants gain insight into the life and work of Carl Jung, one of the most influential figures in the field of psychology.
